ServeWyoming promotes collaborative efforts among private, nonprofit and governmental organizations that advance community service, volunteer programs and activities in each Wyoming community. We also collaborate with other Corporation for National & Community Service programs such as AmeriCorps*VISTA and Senior Corps. ServeWyoming gives every citizen an opportunity to help solve our biggest challenges in education, the environment, public safety, human needs, disaster, youth, and veteran and family services.

In addition to coordinating funding for organizations throughout the state, our Commission has the role of developing, communicating and promoting a statewide vision and ethic of service in Wyoming. To attain this, we are working on a variety of projects which include:

» AMERICORPS*STATE

Provide funding to recruit AmeriCorps members and training to manage and operate AmeriCorps programs across Wyoming. Projects may vary to meet community needs and the application process begins in the fall of each year.

» EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Serve as a neutral convener to mobilize and train volunteers in the time of an emergency or disaster.

» PARTNERSHIP BUILDING

Develop investments and partnerships to sustain ServeWyoming and the programs we support.

» PROFESSIONAL VOLUNTEER NETWORK

Increase nonprofit capacity through the engagement of highly skilled volunteers.

» PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & TRAINING

Increase grantee capacity and statewide awareness of national service through professional development, training and technical assistance, member development and outreach.

» VOLUNTEER GENERATION FUND

Connecting community college students in service learning with nonprofit projects.

» VOLUNTEER WYOMING

Serve as a resource to our communities and increase the number and effectiveness of volunteers in Wyoming.

As Wyoming's statewide resource for volunteerism and service, we feel a responsibility to help unite our community, to use this moment to learn from one another, grow and become stronger. ServeWyoming exists to help solve our communities most challenging problems. We are designed to quickly use our resources to help with critical needs. We are Wyoming strong! I invite you to explore the COVID-19 Initiative and the many volunteer opportunities as a platform to support our community during this trying time.

Wyoming AmeriCorps members are addressing critical needs for COVID-19 now checking in on our seniors, providing food pantry warehouse support, providing non-contact delivery of meals, contacting local nonprofits to recruit/assist with enrollment in the Volunteer Wyoming digital volunteer and donation hub (COVID-19 Initiative), wellness checks, online school/support, and web-based professional development.

AmeriCorps programs do more than move communities forward; they serve their members by creating jobs and providing pathways to opportunity as they enter the workforce. AmeriCorps places thousands of people into intensive service positions where they learn valuable skills, earn money for education, and develop a strong sense of civic responsibility.

We believe that service is one way to extend a lifeline to a new future. In this time of unknowns and loss, we want AmeriCorps service to provide people who need it with a living stipend, health insurance, loan forbearance, and an education award; at the same time, they will in turn be improving the lives of others and strengthening communities. This combination – serving to receive help while helping others – can play a role in helping our state rebuild.

You might be asking yourself, how can I help now? What is virtual volunteering? Today's volunteering includes donating your virtual time and skills to help nonprofits in need. Instead of serving in person, people can find a new place to serve in the virtual world, remotely. This is an opportunity to volunteer from anywhere via phone, computer, or tablet to support a cause you care about. This service can take countless forms including: website design/ support, mentoring, data entry, email marketing or management, fundraising and outreach, social media promotion, app development, volunteer tracking, blogging, writing or editing, graphic design, photography, marketing/branding, video development, staff support, administrative virtual assistant, phone outreach, and so much more.

What is AmeriCorps?

AmeriCorps engages more that 75,000+ Americans in intensive service each year at nonprofits, schools, public agencies, and community and faith-based groups across the county.

Since the program's founding in 1994, ONE MILLION plus AmeriCorps members have contributed more than 1.2 billion hours in service across America while tackling pressing problems and mobilizing millions of volunteers for the organizations they serve.

Governor Gordon announced the 2019-2020 AmeriCorps award recipients on September 4, 2019 to six deserving Wyoming programs that will have 143 members serving our state who will earn close to \$332,000 in Segal Education Awards. Members will apply their skills and ideals towards helping others and meeting critical community needs. As they serve, they also develop valuable job skills and experience, as well as earn a modest education award, which will enhance their careers.

AmeriCorps States is a program of the Corporation for National and Community Service which supports a wide range of community goals in Wyoming that engage citizens, along with thousands of other Americans across the country, in intensive community service each year in the areas of education, disasters, economic opportunity, environment, healthy futures, veterans and family services.


